



Strawberry Refrigerator Cake

1	white cake mix (18.25oz)
1 ½ qt	fresh or frozen Strawberries
½ to ¾ cup	sugar
1	package instant vanilla pudding (3.5oz)
1 cup	milk
1 container	cool whip (8oz)
1 pint	fresh strawberries

- ❖ Prepare cake mix as directed on package. Allow to cool slightly. Poke holes in the top of the cake with end of a wooden spoon.
- ❖ Puree strawberries with the desired amount of sugar in a blender or food processor.
- ❖ Pour the pureed strawberry mixture slowly over the top of the cake.
- ❖ Refrigerate the cake for 45 minutes to 1 hour.
- ❖ Prepare the pudding mix with the milk. Fold the Cool Whip into the pudding mixture and spread over top of cake.
- ❖ Garnish with sliced fresh strawberries.
- ❖ Refrigerate for 3 hours before serving.

Alternate:

Use Cheesecake pudding mix instead of vanilla.

Instead of combining the pudding mix and Cool Whip, spread the pudding mix over the cake first, then spread a layer of Cool Whip over the pudding.

Garnish with strawberries and blueberries for a festive holiday look.
